Lesson: This lesson is about the Cybercrime. Chapter No.3 Data and Privacy

A. Inquiry:

In our last lesson we learned about the Encryption with keys and passwords. We learned that Cybercrime is any illegal activity that uses the internet or computers to commit or facilitate illegal acts. What is Cybercrime? Describe different types of cybercrime.

B. Information:

Cybercrime

A cybercrime is a criminal activity carried out by means of computers and the internet. In some cybercrime, the computer is used to commit crime such as fraud, kidnapping, murder and stealing money from bank account or credit card. The criminals use internet to access the personal information such as username, password, and credit card number.

In other case, computer can be target of cybercrime such as unauthorized access to a computer to spread virus on it. The process of downloading illegal software, music and videos is also considered a cybercrime.

Types of Cybercrime

Different types of cybercrime are as follows:

Identity Theft

Identity theft occurs when a cybercriminal uses another person's personal data like credit card numbers or personal pictures without their permission to commit a fraud or a crime.

Transaction Fraud

The transaction fraud is a criminal activity in which the scammer performs an illegal transaction. Different types of truncation fraud can be as follows:

- 1. The scammer offers an item or online. Some buys the item makes the payment but the scammer never delivers the item.
- 2. The criminal may buy something using the stolen credit card.

Advanced free fraud

The advanced free fraud is a criminal activity in which the criminal informs the user that he has won a prize. He then asks the user to submit a processing fee so the prize may be dispatched. It is very common type cybercrime in which people lose the money.

Hacking

This term refers to the crime of unauthorized access to private computers or networks and misuse of it either by shutting it down or tampering with the data stored or other illegal approaches.

Piracy

Piracy is also a type of cybercrime. Piracy means making illegal copies. It can be a book, software, movies, poetry, painting.
