#### The School

Sadiq Public School is the largest school in Continental Asia and one of Pakistan's leading residential institutions set in 450 acres of land. Founded in 1954, Sadiq Public School comprises the Junior School, the Prep School (Boys) the Senior School (Boys), the Prep School (Girls), the Senior School (Girls) and the Progressive School. It offers education to nearly 2700 pupils aged 3 to 20 years old.

A distinctive feature of Sadiq Public School is its House System with all pupils, whether day or boarding, being members of a House. Boarding numbers at present stand at circa 700 pupils with an intention to increase to 800 plus within a couple of years.

The School is committed to the continuing professional development of its staff. The Principal and CEO, Mr David Dowdles, took up his post in April 2023. He is in the process of reviewing strategy and modernising the management of the School. An ambitious five year plan has been endorsed by the Board.

Our aim is to make Sadiq Public School the best place for all to live, learn and thrive; building on our historic ethos of inclusion and putting children and families at the heart of everything we do. • to assist with the management of budget and resources of the team as agreed by the Principal and CEO


#### **Principal Accountabilities**

Key tasks and accountabilities are intended to be a guide to the range and level of work expected of the post holder. - to deliver psychological services within a framework of consultation to the students
- to ensure reports and interventions delivered by the team are conducted in consultation with staff and students, as appropriate
- to offer psychological intervention to children and young people. Intervention may include a range of approaches, e.g. therapeutic and / or guidance on educational strategies
- to contribute to the professional development of school leaders, teachers and other relevant staff in the Schools as appropriate
- to carry out duties within the overall function, commensurate with the level of the post, to develop and monitor the quality standards of service, to comply with codes of professional ethics
- to deliver training for settings and partners and conduct individual assessments where appropriate
- to manage team meetings and agendas and enable a positive environment for creative team thinking, initiatives and solution-focused thinking
- to carry out such other duties as may be required from time to time to meet the pastoral needs of the students at the School
